Phytosanitary for importing grains and its produce

Plant Protection Division (NPPO-Myanmar) of Department of Agriculture is taking responsibility for issuing Import Certificate and Phytosanitary Certificate for the import and export commodities.

In this regards, import requirement for plants and plant products are available at www.ppdmyanmar.org

Again, Plant Protection Division has requested to NPPOs of trading partners to describe Import Certificate number (4 digits) in the field of Additional Declaration of Phytosanitary Certificate of country of origin from 1st October 2017. Import Certificate will valid for three months from the date issued.
